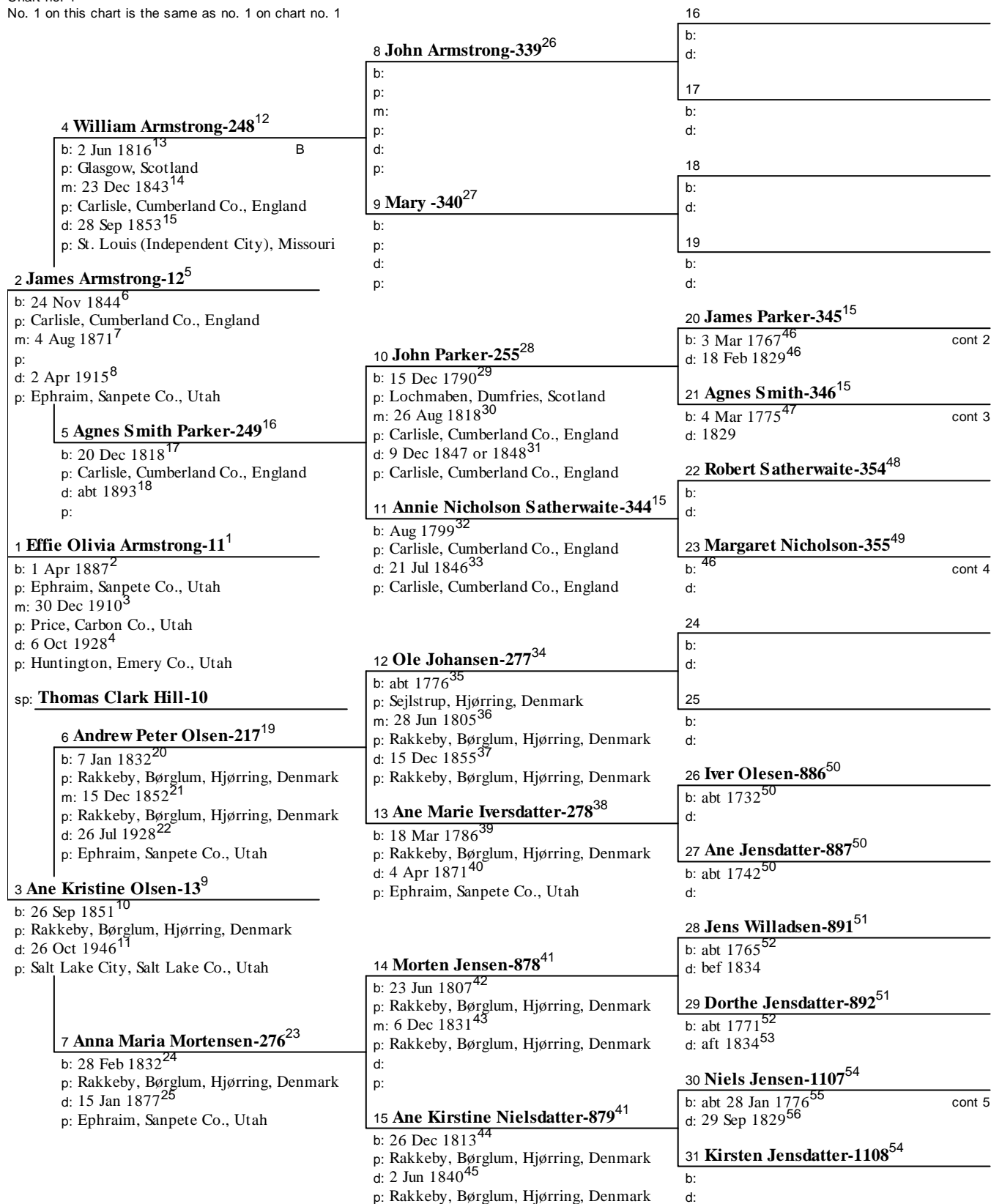


Pedigree Chart - Effie Olivia Armstrong

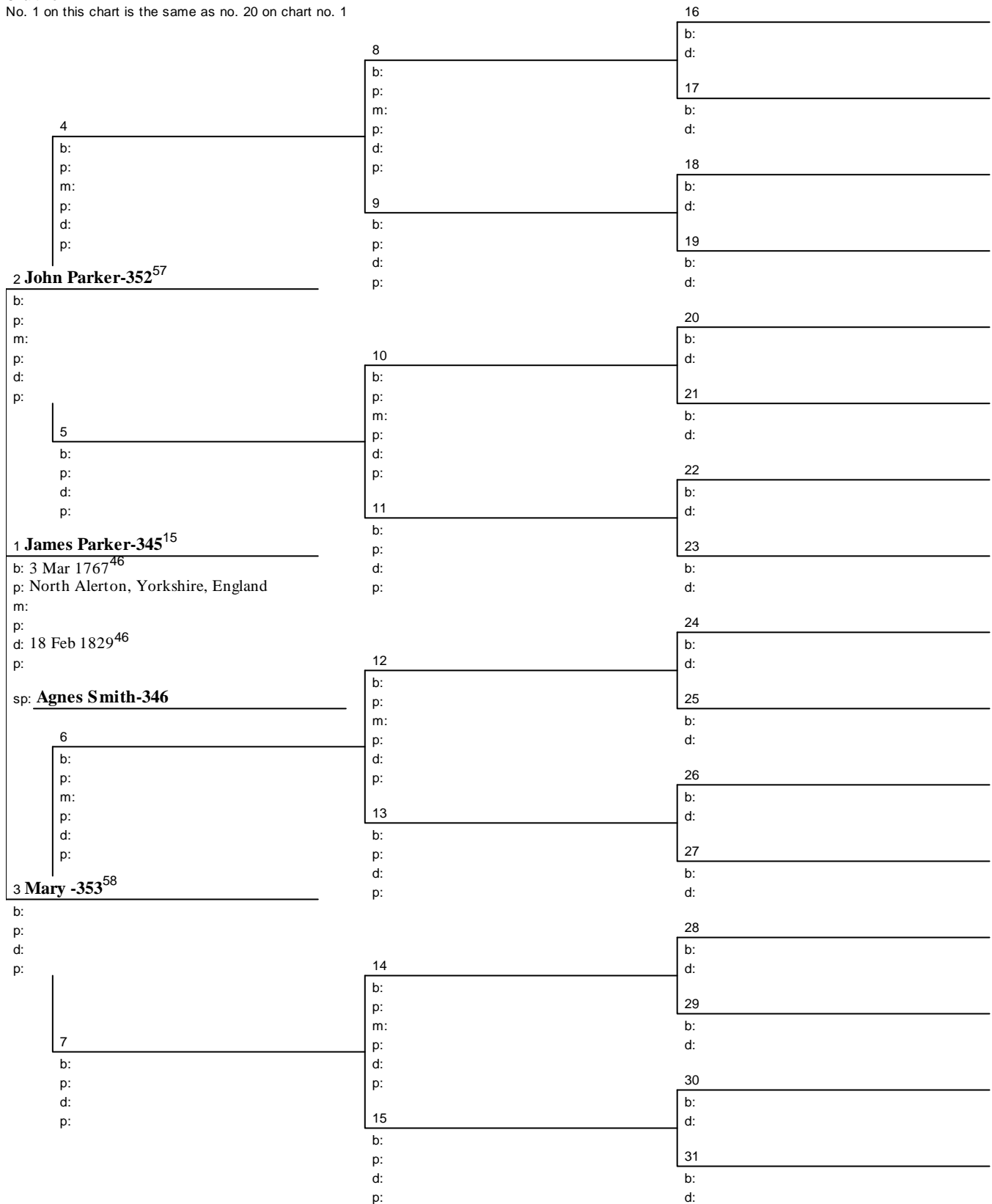


Pedigree Chart - Effie Olivia Armstrong

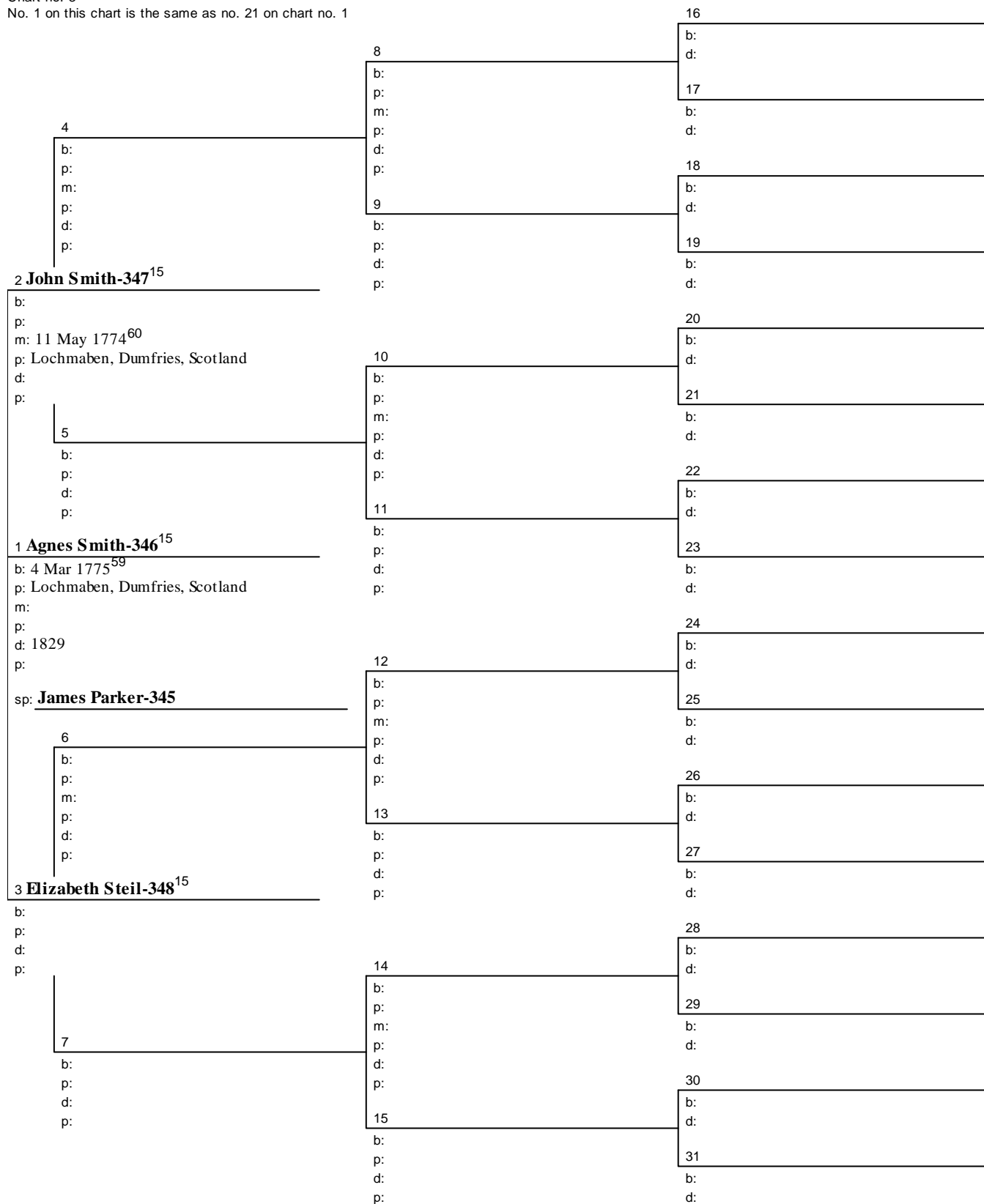

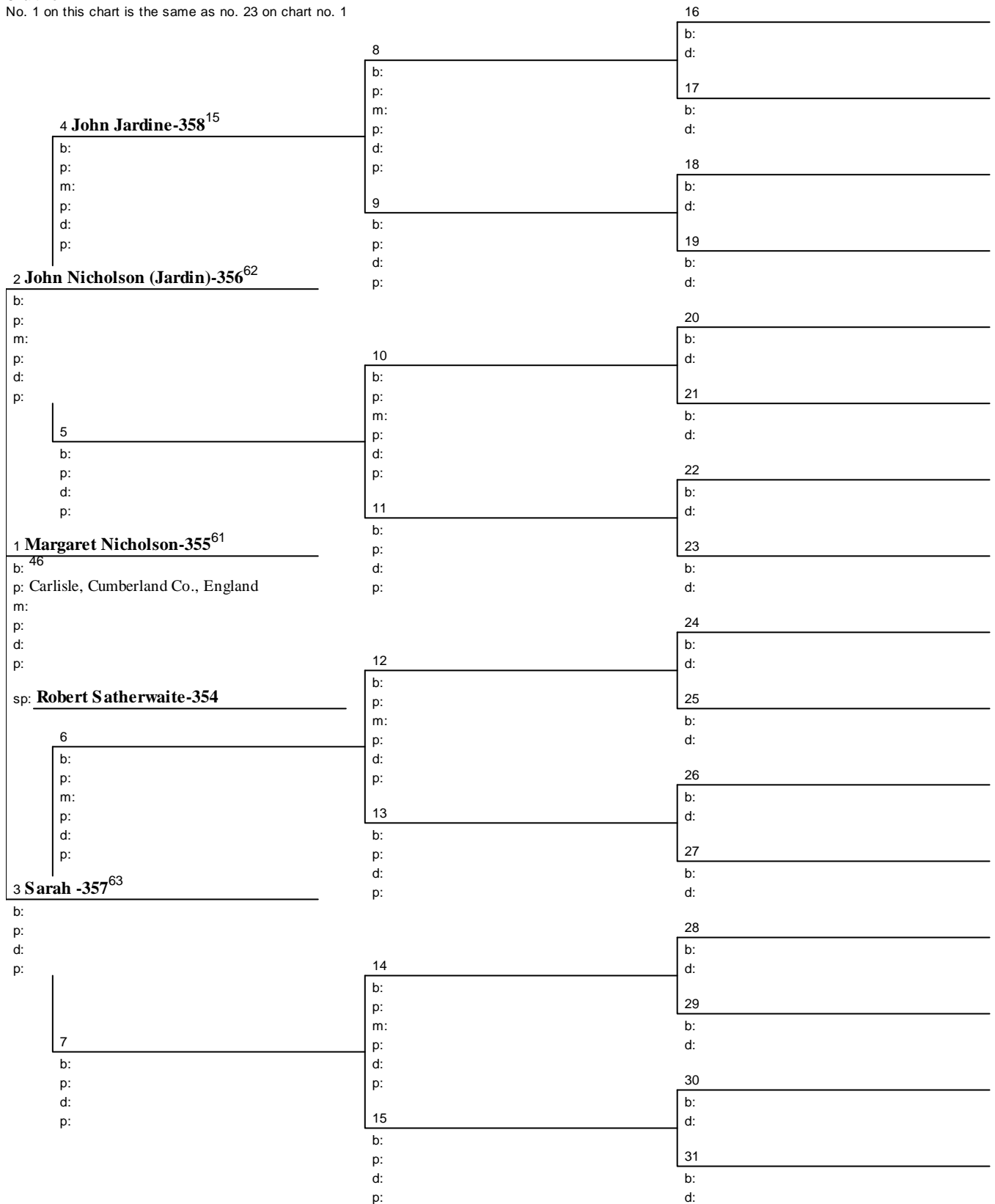

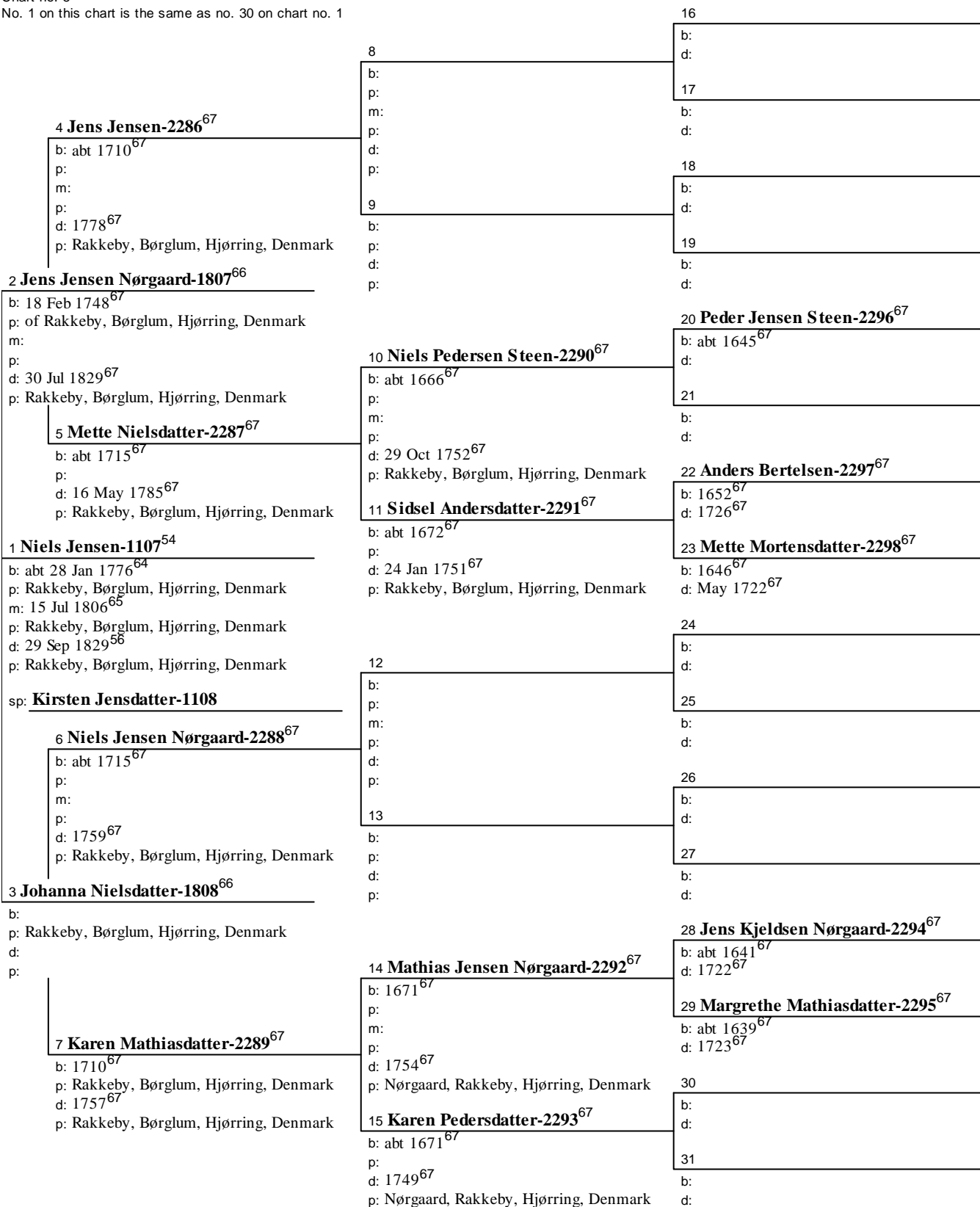
